I/we accept full responsibility for the Wheaten in my care, releasing the previous owner, as well as SCWTCA Rescue and its representatives, of any liability concerning this/these dog(s). If I/we cannot meet the expectations of SCWTCA Rescue for an appropriate foster environment, I/we will immediately relinquish the Wheaten(s) to SCWTCA Rescue.
